HOLY COMMUNION

Holy Communion is currently given after Mass, in St Philip's Chapel in St Wilfrid's Church, or at the Lady Altar in St Joseph's.

- Please leave the church promptly if you are *not* receiving Holy Communion.
- If you *are* receiving the Blessed Sacrament, please follow the one-way system and wait for the previous person to receive before approaching the priest.
- If you wish to make a thanksgiving, please return to the same pew where you were before.
- Five minutes after the last Holy Communion, the church will be closed for cleaning.

COLLECTION

The collection is now taken on your way of church, after Mass. Please be generous: we depend upon you to keep our work going. If you are able to make a standing order, please ask one of the Fathers for details. Also, if you are a taxpayer, please ensure that every donation is gift-aided.

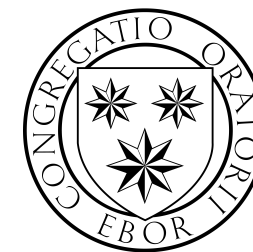
